3. Have all the trainings and proficiency checks as required by Civil Aviation Authority of Nepal valid at the time of induction to Nepal Airlines including but not limiting to:
 - Pilot Proficiency Check
 - Aircraft Type Ground training
 - Emergency Procedures
4. Pass appropriate check with company Instructor Pilot.
5. ICAO/EASA/FAA English Level IV Certificate or higher.
6. Meet the above mentioned fleet specific Requirements.
