Travelling to several countries for 10 days before arriving to Qatar	For non-immune group A passengers who have travelled to multiple countries over the past 10 days, to benefit from quarantine privileges for classifying countries with a lower risk level, passengers must stay in a lower-level country for at least 10 days before arriving to Qatar					
Treatment abroad	Citizens travelling non-immune and returning from overseas treatment trips must submit a health certificate (by pre-registration through the www.ehteraz.gov.qa website) issued from the Committee for Medical Treatment Abroad
