1. Devanagari Typing Marking (words per minute)

3. The texts typed in Devanagari and English will be checked by matching them with the given texts. The words missing punctuation marks in the given places will not be counted both in Devanagari and English typing. After this, the correct words per minute will be calculated by using following formula:
