Definition:

Air Operator

A person organization or the enterprise engaged in or offering to engage in an aircraft operation under an Air Operator Certificate issued by the CAAN.

Air Operator Certificate (AOC)

A certificate authorizing an operator to carry out specified commercial air transport operations.

Certify as airworthy

To certify that an aircraft or parts thereof comply with current airworthiness requirements after maintenance has been performed on the aircraft or parts thereof.

Certificate of Airworthiness

The formal document issued by the National Aviation Authority (NAA) to certify that an aircraft is airworthy.

Dry Lease

A lease of aircraft without the crew. In this case the aircraft is normally registered in the AOC holder's State, bears the lessee's AOC holder name/logo and is operated under the AOC of the Lessee.

Foreign Operator

Any operator that holds an AOC issued by one state and that operates, or seeks to operate, into the airspace above the territory of another state.

Leased Aircraft

An aircraft as one used under a contractual leasing arrangements.

Lessor

The person, part or the AOC holder from whom the aircraft is leased.

Lessee

The person, party of the AOC holder to which the aircraft is leased.

Maintenance

The performance of tasks required to ensure the continuing airworthiness of an aircraft, including any one or combination of overhaul, inspection, replacement defect rectification, and the embodiment of a modification or repair.

Operational control: The exercise of authority over the initiation, continuation, diversion or termination of a flight in the interest of the safety of the aircraft and the regularity and efficiency of the flight.

State of operator

The state in which the Operator's principal place of business is located or, if there is no such place of business, the operator's permanent residence.

Sate of registry

The state on whose registry the aircraft is entered.

5. Sealed bids must be submitted to the office of Nepal Airlines Corporation, Kantipath, Kathmandu, Nepal by hand/courier on or before 12:00 PM on 16th November 2022 Bids received after this deadline will be rejected.
6. Bids must be valid for a period of 120 days from the date of bid opening and must be accompanied by a bid security amounting to 10% of the total offered lease rent of one

month, which shall be valid for 30 days beyond the validity period of the bid (i.e. 15th April, 2023).

7. If the last date of submission falls on a government holiday, then the next working day shall be considered as the last date. In such case the validity period of the bid security shall remain the same as specified for the original last date of bid submission.

Section I. Instructions to Bidders

Section I. Instructions to Bidders

A. General

1. Scope of Bid

1.1 The Nepal Airlines (hereinafter referred to as “Lessor”), with its Head Office located at Kantipath, Kathmandu, Nepal **indicated in the BDS** issues this Bidding Document for the Lease Out of MA-60 and Y12-E Aircraft thereto as specified in Section VI, List of Fleet and its spare parts. The name, identification, and number are provided in the **BDS**.

1.2 Throughout this Bidding Document:

1.2.1 the term “in writing” means communicated in written form.

1.2.2 “day” means calendar day.

2. Fraud and Corruption

2.1 Lessor requires that the procuring entities as well as bidders, Lessee and their sub-contractors shall adhere to the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of such contracts. In this context, the Lessor;

(a) defines, for the purposes of this provision, the terms set forth below as follows:

(i) “corrupt practice” means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting, directly or indirectly, anything of value to influence improperly the actions of another party;

(ii) “fraudulent practice” means any act or omission, including a misrepresentation, that knowingly or recklessly misleads, or attempts to mislead, a party to obtain a financial or other benefit or to avoid an obligation;

(iii) “coercive practice” means impairing or harming, or threatening to impair or harm, directly or indirectly, any party or the property of the party to influence improperly the actions of a party;

(iv) “Collusive practice” means an arrangement between two or more parties designed to achieve an improper purpose, including influencing improperly the actions of another party.

(v) “obstructive practice” means:

(aa) deliberately destroying, falsifying, altering or concealing of evidence material to the investigation or making false statements to investigators in order to materially impede a Lessor investigation into allegations of a corrupt, fraudulent, coercive or collusive practice; and/or threatening, harassing or intimidating any party to prevent it from disclosing its knowledge of matters relevant to the investigation or from pursuing the investigation; or

(bb) acts intended to materially impede the exercise of the Lessor inspection and audit rights.

(cc) will reject bid(s) if it determines that the bidder has, directly or through an agent, engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, coercive, or obstructive practices in competing for the contract in question;

(dd) will sanction a firm or individual, including declaring ineligible, for a stated period of time, to be awarded a contract if it at any time determines that the firm has, directly or through an agent, engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, coercive, or obstructive practices in competing for, or in executing, a contract.

2.2 The Bidder shall not carry out or cause to carry out the following acts with an intention to influence the implementation of the procurement process or the procurement agreement:

(a) give or propose improper inducement directly or indirectly,

(b) distortion or misrepresentation of facts,

(c) engaging in corrupt or fraudulent practice or involving in such act,

(d) interference in participation of other competing bidders,

(e) coercion or threatening directly or indirectly to cause

harm to the person or the property of any person to be involved in the procurement proceedings,

- (f) collusive practice among bidders before or after submission of bids for distribution of works among bidders or fixing artificial/uncompetitive bid price with an intention to deprive the Employer the benefit of open competitive bid price,
- (g) Contacting the Employer with an intention to influence the Employer with regards to the bids or interference of any kind in examination and evaluation of the bids during the period from the time of opening of the bids until the notification of award of contract.

2.3 PPMO on the recommendation of the Lessor may blacklist a Bidder for a period of one (1) to three (3) years for its conduct including the following grounds and seriousness of the act committed by the bidder:

- (a) if convicted by a court of law in a criminal offence which disqualifies the Bidder from participating in the contract,
- (b) if it is established that the contract agreement signed by the Bidder was based on false or misrepresentation of Bidder's qualification information,

2.4 A bidder declared blacklisted and ineligible by the Lessor, Public procurement Monitoring Office (PPMO) shall be ineligible to bid for a contract during the period of time determined by the GoN.

3. Eligible Bidders

3.1 The Bidder shall be domestic/international Air Operator and shall have valid Air Operator's Certificate from the concerned authority (CAA) and a minimum of one Aircraft in Operation in the state of registry.

3.2 A Bidder shall not have a conflict of interest. All Bidders found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified. A Bidder may be considered to be in a conflict of interest with one or more parties in this bidding process if, including but not limited to:

- (a) have controlling shareholders in common; or
- (b) receive or have received any direct or indirect subsidy from any of them; or
- (c) have the same legal representative for purposes of this Bid;

or

(d) have a relationship with each other, directly or through common third parties, that puts them in a position to have access to information about or influence on the Bid of another Bidder, or influence the decisions of the Lessor regarding this bidding process; or

- 3.3 A Bidder that is under a declaration of ineligibility by the Government of Nepal in accordance with ITB 2, at the date of the deadline for bid submission or thereafter, shall be disqualified.
- 3.4 Government-owned enterprises in Nepal shall be eligible only if they can establish that they (i) are legally and financially autonomous, (ii) operate under the principles of commercial law, and (iii) are not dependent agencies of the Lessor.
- 3.5 Bidders shall provide such evidence of their continued eligibility satisfactory to the Lessor, as the Lessor shall reasonably request.
- 3.6 All Bidders shall be eligible only if the bidder has obtained company Registration certificate(s) and latest Tax clearance certificate or proof of submission of income return and other documents as stated in BDS.
- 3.7 The Bidder shall comply with the requirements of the state of registry as per Air Operator Certificate Requirements – 2012, Second edition November 2012, Amdt.no.03 dated 12-12-2016 (and/or any future amendments to this manual), Chapter 9- Aircraft Leasing Requirements, and the state of operator in addition to article 83 bis to the Chicago Convention.
- 3.8 The Bidder shall have a minimum paid up capital of USD 5 million and a minimum of USD 20 million working capital and average annual turnover for the last three years shall be USD 3.5 Million.
- 3.9 The bidder must quote equivalent or value higher than the minimum rent as specified in Section IV(h) or shall be considered disqualified.
- 3.10 The bidder must submit the bid for the remaining declared life as specified in Section IV(h) or shall be considered disqualified.
- 3.11 Bidders are required to submit signed Insurance Commitment on agreed insurance policy in its official corporate letterhead confirming to comply with all insurance requirements as specified in Section IV(g) The alteration, modification, and/or taking exception to any

and all sections of this letter will not be accepted and may result in a determination of Non-Responsiveness for Contract Award.

4. Site Visit

- 4.1 For Lease-Out of Fleet, the Bidder may visit and examine the Site and obtain all information that may be necessary for preparing the Bid and entering into a contract for the lease of equipment.
 - 4.1.1 All Fleet and Spare Parts/Tools (as per Section VI) sare physically located at NAC Hangar premises, Tribhuvan International Airport, Kathmandu, Nepal.
- 4.2 The Bidder should ensure that the Lessor is informed of the visit in adequate time to allow it to make appropriate arrangements. For security clearance purposes the names and ID/passport numbers of visitors should be provided in advance by email.
- 4.3 The costs of visiting the Site shall be at the Bidder's own expense. A site visit can be requested by contacting via email to the Office of the Corporate Department, NAC at Kantipath, Kathmandu, Nepal corporatedir@nac.com.np, cfb@nac.com.np.

5. Sections of the Bidding Document

- The Bidding Document consist of Parts 1 and 2 which include all the Sections indicated below, and should be read in conjunction with any Addenda issued in accordance with ITB 6.

- 5.1 The Invitation for Bids issued by the Lessor is not part of the Bidding Document.
- 5.2 The Lessor is not responsible for the completeness of the Bidding Document and its addenda, if they were not obtained directly from the Lessor.
- 5.3 The Bidder is expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms, and specifications in the Bidding Document. Failure to furnish all information or documentation required by the Bidding Document may result in the rejection of the Bid.
- 5.4 The bidder must consider that the Equipment are leased on "as-is-where-is" basis and the successful bidder is responsible for all costs, including but not limited to, maintenance and transportation of the items in accordance with laws and regulations of state of Registry and state of Operator.
- 5.5 If the bidder sub contracts the contract, the lesse should inform the bidder of such sub contracts mandatorily. The sub-contractor shall fulfill respective CAAs requirements.

6. Clarification of Bidding Document

- 6.1 A prospective Bidder requiring any clarification of the Bidding Document shall contact the Lessor in writing at the Lessor's address indicated in the **BDS**. The Lessor will respond in writing to any request for clarification, provided that such request is received within the time limit specified in the **BDS** prior to the deadline for submission of Bids. The Lessor shall forward copies of its response to all Bidders who have acquired the Bidding Document directly from it, including a description of the inquiry but without identifying its source. Should the Lessor deem it necessary to amend the Bidding Document as a result of a clarification, it shall do so following the procedure under ITB 7 and 19.2.
- 6.2 Authorized Signature/ Stamp on all pages at the right corner of this Tender document. Any modification in the Tender Bid document shall be initialled with the signature of the authorized person.
- 6.3 Fully completed Section 4 of this Tender document clearly mentioning the Tender Bid price (financial offer), clearly specifying the name, signature and the title of the authorized representative of the Bidder and contact details.

- 6.4 If Bidder is an individual – Notarized copies of Identification documents along with Tax clearance certificate issued by concerned Government entity.
- 6.5 If Bidder is a private/ public company/ organization – Notarized copies of the Company Registration certificate and the Tax Clearance certificate issued by concerned Government entity.
- 6.6 Signed copy of Declaration in letter head
- 6.7 A valid Bid Bond.
- 6.8 Authorization Letter - Sealed Tender if submitted by a local agent, must be accompanied by an authorization letter stating that the bearer is an authorized representative or local agent. Bidder, who has a local agent or representative in Nepal, must state the name(s) and address (es) and the amount of commission being paid for this job, if any, in the authorization letter.
- 6.9 Local agent of foreign bidders (if any) must be registered in Income Tax office and Company registrar office of Nepal and should submit the registration certificates and last fiscal year tax clearance certificate.

7. Amendment of Bidding Document

- 7.1 At any time prior to the deadline for submission of the Bids, the Lessor may amend the Bidding Document by issuing addenda.
- 7.2 Any addendum issued shall be part of the Bidding Document and shall be communicated in writing to all who have obtained the Bidding Document directly from the Lessor.
- 7.3 To give prospective Bidders reasonable time in which to take an addendum into account in preparing their Bids, the Lessor may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of the Bids, pursuant to **ITB 19.2**

C. Preparation of Bids

8. Cost of Bidding

- 8.1 The Bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its Bid, and the Lessor shall not be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.

9. Language of Bid

- 9.1 The Bid, as well as all correspondence and documents relating to the Bid exchanged by the Bidder and the Lessor, shall be written in

English language, **specified in the BDS**. Supporting documents and printed literature that are part of the Bid may be in another language provided they are accompanied by an accurate translation of the relevant passages in the language **specified in the BDS**, in which case, for purposes of interpretation of the Bid, such translation shall govern.

**10. Documents
Comprising the Bid**

10.1 The Bid shall comprise the following:

- (a) Bid Submission Sheet
- (b) Lease Rental Schedules, in accordance with ITB Clauses **11**, and **12**
- (c) Bid Security, in accordance with ITB **16**
- (d) written confirmation authorizing the signatory of the Bid to commit the Bidder, in accordance with ITB **17**
- (e) documentary evidence in accordance with ITB **13** establishing the Bidder's eligibility to bid;
- (f) documentary evidence in accordance with ITB **14** establishing the Bidder's qualifications to perform the contract if its Bid is accepted;

**11. Bid Submission Sheet and
Lease Rent Schedules**

11.1 The Bidder shall submit the Bid Submission Sheet using the form furnished in **Section IV, Bidding Forms**. This form must be completed without any alterations to its format, and no substitutes shall be accepted. All blank spaces shall be filled in with the information requested.

11.2 The Bidder shall submit the Rental Schedules for Equipment, according to their origin as appropriate, using the forms furnished in **Section IV, Bidding Forms**.

12. Currencies of Bid

12.1 Bid prices shall be quoted in USD.

**13. Documents Establishing the
Eligibility of the Bidder**

13.1 To establish their eligibility in accordance with ITB 3, Bidders shall complete the eligibility declarations in the Bid Submission Sheet, included in **Section IV, Bidding Forms**

14. Documents Establishing the

14.1 The documentary evidence of the Bidder's qualifications to perform the contract, if its bid is accepted, shall

Qualifications of the Bidder

establish to the Lessor's satisfaction that the Bidder meets each of the qualification criterion specified in **Section III, Evaluation Criteria.**

- 14.2 A foreign Bidder wishing to have or already having a local agent shall state the following:
- a. Name and address of the Agent/Representative,
 - b. The Agent/Representative providing type of services,
 - c. Amount of commission if the Agent/Representative is entitled to get such payment and if it participates in the procedure of payment,
 - d. Other agreement with Agent/Representative, if any,
 - e. Bidder shall certify in the Letter of Authorization for the appointment of local agent/representative.

15. Period of Validity of Bids

- 15.1 Bid shall remain valid for a period **specified in the BDS** after the bid submission deadline date prescribed by the lessor. A bid valid for a shorter period shall be rejected by the lessor as nonresponsive.
- 15.2 In exceptional circumstances, prior to the expiration of the bid validity period, the Lessor may request Bidders to extend the period of validity of their Bids. The request and the responses shall be made in writing. If a Bid Security is requested in accordance with **ITB16**, it shall also be extended for a corresponding period. A Bidder may refuse the request without forfeiting its Bid Security. A Bidder granting the request shall not be required or permitted to modify its Bid and to include any additional conditions against the provisions specified in Bid Documents.

16. Bid Security

- 16.1 Unless otherwise *specified in the BDS*, the Bidder shall furnish as part of its bid, in original form, a Bid Security *as specified in the BDS*.
- 16.2 If a bid security is specified pursuant to **ITB 16.1**, the bid security shall be in any of the following forms at the Bidder's option:

- (a) original copy of an unconditional bank guarantee from reputed commercial foreign bank or;
- (b) original copy of an unconditional bank guarantee from ‘A’ class Commercial Bank eligible to issue Bank Guarantee as per prevailing Law in Nepal or;
- (c) **original copy of cash** deposit voucher in the Lessor’s Account as *specified in BDS*.

In case of a bank guarantee, the Bid Security shall be submitted using the Bid Security Form included in *Section IV, Bidding Forms*. The form must include the complete name of the Bidder. The Bid Security shall be valid for minimum thirty (30) days beyond the end of the validity period of the bid. This shall also apply if the period for bid validity is extended.

A bid security issued by foreign bank must be counter – guaranteed by an ‘A’ Class Commercial Bank eligible to issue Bank Guarantee as per prevailing Law in Nepal acceptable to Lessor.

- 16.3 If a bid Security is required in accordance with ITB **16.1**, any Bid not accompanied by an enforceable and compliant Bid Security in accordance with ITB **16.2**, shall be rejected by the Lessor as nonresponsive.
- 16.4 If a Bid Security is specified pursuant to ITB **16.1**, the Bid Security of unsuccessful Bidders will be returned within Fifteen (15) days upon the successful Bidder furnishing of the signed Contract Agreement and the Performance Security pursuant to ITB **35**.
- 16.5 If a Bid Security is specified pursuant to ITB **16.1**, the Bid Security of the successful Bidder shall be returned as promptly as possible once the successful Bidder has signed the Contract Agreement and furnished the required Performance Security.
- 16.6 The Bid Security may be forfeited:
 - (a) if a Bidder withdraws its Bid during the period of bid validity specified by the Bidder on the Bid Submission Sheet, except as provided in ITB **16.2**; or
 - (b) if the successful Bidder fails to:

- (i) sign the Contract in accordance with ITB **36**; or
- (ii) furnish a Performance Security in accordance with ITB **35**.

17. Format and Signing of Bid

- 17.1 The Bidder shall prepare documents comprising the Bid as described in ITB 10.
- 17.2 The Bid documents shall be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed by a person duly authorized to sign on behalf of the Bidder. This authorization shall be attached with the Bid.
- 17.3 Any amendments such as interlineations, erasures, or overwriting shall be valid only if they are signed or initialed by the person signing the Bid.

D. Submission and Opening of Bids

18. Submission, Sealing and Marking of Bids

- 18.1 Bidders may always submit their bids by hand or by courier.
- 18.2 If all envelopes are not sealed and marked as required, the Lessor will assume no responsibility for the misplacement or premature opening of the bid.

19. Deadline for Submission of Bids

- 19.1 Bids must be received at the address and no later than the date and time *indicated in the BDS*.
- 19.2 Lessor may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of Bids by amending the Bidding Document in accordance with ITB 7, in which case all rights and obligations of Lessor and Lessee previously subject to the deadline shall thereafter be subject to the deadline as extended.

20. Late Bids

- 20.1 The Lessor shall not consider any Bid that arrives after the deadline for submission of Bids, in accordance with ITB **19**. Any Bid received by NAC after the deadline for submission of Bids shall be declared late and rejected.

21. Withdrawal of Bids

- 21.1 A Bidder may withdraw its Bid after it has been submitted by sending a written Notice in a sealed envelope, duly signed by an authorized representative, and shall include a copy of the

authorization in accordance with ITB **17.2**. The corresponding withdrawal of the Bid must accompany the respective written Notice. All Notices must be:

- (a) submitted in accordance with ITB Clauses **17** and **18** (except that Withdrawal Notices do not require copies), and in addition, the respective envelopes shall be clearly marked “Withdrawal” and
- (b) received by the Lessor 24 hours prior to the deadline prescribed for submission of bids.

21.2 Bids requested to be withdrawn in accordance with ITB 21.1 shall be unopened.

21.3 No Bid shall be withdrawn in the interval between the deadline for submission of bids and the expiration of the period of bid validity specified by the Bidder on the Bid Submission Sheet or any extension thereof.

Sealed envelope pursuant to ITB 21.1 shall be opened only on the date and time of opening of bid.

22. Bid Opening

22.1 The Lessor shall conduct the bid opening in the presence of bidder or its representative who chose to attend at the address, date and time specified in the **BDS**.

22.2 Before opening the bids the Lessor shall separate the envelopes of the bids received after the deadline of bid submission, the envelopes containing an application given for “WITHDRAWAL”, of bids and the envelopes of bids duly registered. Then envelopes marked “WITHDRAWAL” shall be opened first, read out, and recorded, and the envelope containing the corresponding Bid shall not be opened. If the withdrawal notice is not accompanied by a copy of the valid authorization pursuant to ITB **18.2**, the withdrawal shall not be permitted and the corresponding Bid will be opened.

22.3 All other envelopes shall be opened one at a time, and the following read out and recorded: the name of the Bidder; the Bid Prices (per Fleet if applicable); the presence of a Bid Security, if required; if there is discrepancy between figure and words, description of such discrepancy; whether the bid form is signed by

the bidder or his agent; and any other details as the Lessor may consider appropriate. No Bid shall be rejected at bid opening except for late bids, in accordance with ITB **20.1**.

- 22.4 The Lessor shall prepare a record of the bid opening that shall include, as a minimum: the name of the Bidder and whether there is a withdrawal of the Bid, the Bid Price, per fleet if applicable, and the presence or absence of a Bid Security. The Bidders' representatives who are present shall be requested to sign the record. The omission of a Bidder's signature on the record shall not invalidate the contents and effect of the record. The Bidders' representatives who are present shall also be requested to sign an attendance sheet.

E. Evaluation and Comparison of Bids

23. Confidentiality

- 23.1 Information relating to the examination, evaluation, comparison, and post-qualification of Bids, and recommendation of contract award, shall not be disclosed to Bidders or any other persons not officially concerned with such process until publication of the Contract award; thereafter, information will be disclosed in accordance with ITB **36.2**.
- 23.2 Any attempt by a Bidder to influence the Lessor in the examination, evaluation, comparison, and post-qualification of the Bids or Contract award decisions may result in the rejection of its Bid.
- 23.3 from the time of bid opening to the time of Contract award, if any Bidder wishes to contact the Lessor on any matter related to the bidding process, it should do so in writing.

24. Clarification of Bids

- 24.1 To assist in the examination, evaluation, comparison and post-qualification of the Bids, the Lessor may, at its discretion, ask any Bidder for a clarification of its Bid. Any clarification submitted by a Bidder with regard to its Bid and that is not in response to a request by the Lessor shall not be considered. The Lessor's request for clarification and the response shall be in writing. No change in the Rental or substance of the Bid shall be sought, offered, or permitted, except to confirm the

correction of arithmetic errors discovered by the Lessor in the evaluation of the Bids, in accordance with ITB **28**.

25. Deviations, Reservations, and Omissions

- 25.1 During the evaluation of bids, the following definitions apply:
- (a) “Deviation” is a departure from the requirements specified in the Bidding Document;
 - (b) “Reservation” is the setting of limiting conditions or withholding from complete acceptance of the requirements specified in the Bidding Document; and
 - (c) “Omission” is the failure to submit part or all of the information or documentation required in the Bidding Document.

26. Determination of Responsiveness

- 26.1 The Lessor’s determination of the responsiveness of a Bid is to be based on the contents of the Bid itself, as defined in ITB 10.
- 26.2 A substantially responsive bid is one that meets the requirements of the Bidding Document without material deviation, reservation, or omission. A material deviation, reservation, or omission is one that,
- (i) if accepted, would limits in any substantial way, inconsistent with the Bidding Document, the Lessor’s rights or the Bidder’s obligations under the proposed Contract;
 - (ii) if rectified, would unfairly affect the competitive position of other Bidders presenting substantially responsive bids.
- 26.3 The Lessor shall examine the technical aspects of the bid in particular, to confirm that all requirements of **Section VI, Technical Details** have been met without any deviation.

27. Non-material Non-conformities

- 27.1 Provided that a Bid is substantially responsive, the Lessor may waive any non-conformity in the bid that does not constitute a material deviation, reservation or omission.
- 27.2 Provided that a Bid is substantially responsive, the Lessor may request that the Bidder submit

the necessary information or documentation, within a reasonable period of time, to rectify non-material non-conformities or omissions in the Bid related to documentation requirements. Requesting information or documentation on such nonconformities shall not be related to any aspect of the price of the Bid. Failure of the Bidder to comply with the request may result in the rejection of its Bid.

28. Correction of Arithmetical Errors

28.1 Provided that the Bid is substantially responsive, the Lessor shall correct arithmetical errors on the following basis:

- (a) if there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected, unless in the opinion of the Lessor there is an obvious misplacement of the decimal point in the unit price, in which case the total price as quoted shall govern and the unit price shall be corrected;
- (b) if there is an error in a total corresponding to the addition or subtraction of subtotals, the subtotals shall prevail and the total shall be corrected; and
- (c) if there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail, unless the amount expressed in words is related to an arithmetic error, in which case the amount in figures shall prevail subject to (a) and (b) above.

28.2 If the Bidder that submitted the highest evaluated Bid does not accept the correction of errors, its Bid shall be rejected and its bid security shall be forfeited.

29. Evaluation of Bids

29.1 The Lessor shall evaluate each Bid that has been determined, up to this stage of the evaluation, to be substantially responsive.

29.2 To evaluate a Bid, the Lessor shall only use all the criteria and methodologies defined in this Clause and in **Section III, Evaluation Criteria**. No other criteria or methodology shall be permitted.

29.3 To evaluate a Bid, the Lessor shall consider the

following:

(a) evaluation will be done for Fleet, as **specified in the BDS**; the bid price as quoted in accordance with ITB **16**;

(b) price adjustment for correction of arithmetic errors in accordance with ITB **28.1**;

29.4 The Lessor's evaluation of a bid may require the consideration of other factors, in addition to the Bid Price quoted in accordance with ITB Clause 15. The effect of the factors selected, if any, shall be expressed in monetary terms to facilitate comparison of bids as specified in Section III, Evaluation Criteria. The factors, methodologies and criteria to be used shall be as specified in ITB 29.2 and IBT 29.3

29.5 If so specified in the BDS, these Bidding Documents shall allow Bidders to quote separate prices for one or both Fleet type, and shall allow the Lessor to award one or both Fleet type to highest Bidder of the Fleet. The methodology of evaluation to determine the highest-evaluated Fleet combinations is specified in Section III, Evaluation Criteria.

30. Comparison of Bids

30.1 The Lessor shall compare all substantially responsive bids to determine the highest-evaluated bid, in accordance with ITB **29**.

31. Post-qualification of the Bidder

31.1 The Lessor shall determine to its satisfaction whether the Bidder that is selected as having submitted the highest evaluated and substantially responsive Bid is qualified to perform the Contract satisfactorily.

31.2 The determination shall be based upon an examination of the documentary evidence of the Bidder's qualifications submitted by the Bidder, pursuant to ITB **14**.

32. Lessor's Right to Accept Any Bid, and to Reject Any or All Bids

32.1 The Lessor reserves the right to accept or reject any Bid, and to annul the bidding process and reject all Bids at any time prior to Contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the Bidders if;

- The Tender form is incomplete,

- Any condition mentioned in the Tender, which the bidder considers essential, contradicts the Tender document,
- The Tender Document is not properly sealed,
- The Tender Document is not duly signed and stamped by the bidder or his authorized person,
- The offer is not duly quoted as instructed in this document,
- The Document is not submitted within stipulated date and time.
- The Tender Document is NOT accompanied by the Bid Bond.

F. Award of Contract

33. Award Criteria

33.1 The Lessor shall select for awarding the Contract to the Bidder whose offer has been determined to be the highest evaluated Bid and is substantially responsive to the Bidding Document, provided further that the Bidder is determined to be qualified to perform the Contract satisfactorily.

34. Notification of Intention to Award

34.1 The Lessor shall notify the concerned Bidder whose bid has been selected within seven days of the selection of the bid, in writing that the Lessor has intention to accept the bid and the information regarding name, address and bid amount of the selected bidder shall be given to all other bidders using the “Letter of Intention”

34.2 If no bidder submits an application pursuant to ITB **37.1** within a period of seven days of providing the notice under ITB **34.1**, the Lessor shall accept the bid selected in accordance with ITB **33.1** prior to the expiry of bid validity period, and notification of award shall be communicated to the bidder to furnish the performance security and sign the contract within Thirty-Five (35) days.

34.3 In Case, a corruption case is being filed to Court against the Board of Director of the firm/institution /company. Such Board of Director of the firm/institution /company and such bidder’s bid shall be excluded from the

evaluation, if NAC receives instruction from Government of Nepal.

35. Performance Security

- 35.1 Within fifteen (15) days of the receipt of notification of award from the Lessor, the successful Bidder shall furnish the Performance Security, Contract Forms, or another form acceptable to the Lessor.
- 35.2 Failure of the successful Bidder to submit the above-mentioned Performance Security or sign the Contract Agreement shall constitute sufficient grounds for the annulment of the award and forfeiture of the Bid Security. In that event the Lessor may award the Contract to the next highest evaluated Bidder whose offer is substantially responsive and is determined by the Lessor to be qualified to perform the Contract satisfactorily.

36. Signing of Contract

- 36.1 The successful Bidder shall sign the contract after the submission of performance security in accordance with ITB 35.
- 36.2 At the same time, the Lessor shall affix a public notice on the result of the award on its notice board and make arrangement to post the notice into its website, the contract award results identifying the bid and Fleet and the following information: (v) name of the winning Bidder, and the Price it offered.
- 36.3 The Lessor shall promptly respond via email to all unsuccessful Bidder.

37. Complaint and Review

- 37.1 If a Bidder, is not satisfied with the Lease process or NAC's decision provided as per ITB 33.1 and believes that the NAC has committed an error or breach of duty which has or will result in loss to the Bidder then the Bidder may give an application for review of the decision to the Managing Director of Lessor with reference to the error or breach of duty committed by NAC. The complaint application should be given within 7 days of receipt of the information regarding the issue of intention to accept letter by NAC. Application, for review of NAC's decision, filed after the deadline shall not be processed.
- 37.2 The Managing Director of the Lessor, within five (5) days after receiving the complaint application, give its decision with reasons, in writing pursuant to ITB 37.1:

(a) whether to suspend the Lease-Out proceeding and the procedure for further proceedings to be adopted; or

(b) whether or not to reject a complaint application.

38. Delivery/Re-delivery

38.1 The Leased-out Fleet shall be delivered/redelivered at NAC Hanger TIA, Kathmandu.

38.2 All the associated costs with regards to point ITB 38.1 shall be borne by the Lessee.

39. Monitoring

39.1 The Lessee should submit the monthly report of maintenance status and Technical records (FH, FC etc) of leased aircraft within 7 days of the following month.

39.2 The Lessee should facilitate the Lessor for visit and monitoring of leased aircraft in frequent interval.

Section V. Technical Aspect

1. Lawful and Safe Operation

- 1.1 Lessee will operate the Aircraft for commercial purposes from the Delivery Date until the Return Occasion from such other base outside the State of Registry provided that Lessee must not use or operate Aircraft or suffer or permit the Aircraft to be used or operated:
- (a) (i) in violation of any applicable Regulations except to the extent that such Regulations are being contested in good faith (but excluding any Regulation, such as a mandatory grounding order, the good faith contest of which does not permit Lessee to operate the Aircraft during such contest); provided, however, that no contest of a Regulation shall be allowed if such contest might subject Lessor to criminal sanctions or a material risk of sale, loss or forfeiture of the Aircraft, Airframe, an Engine or Lessor's interest in any of the foregoing; or such violation is unanticipated, minor and non-recurring.
(ii) in a manner causing Lessor to be in violation of any applicable Regulations; or
(iii) in any manner whatsoever which Lessee is aware may render the Aircraft liable to a material risk of condemnation, destruction, seizure or confiscation by any Person;
 - (b) for any purpose for which the Aircraft was not designed or is not reasonably suitable;
 - (c) to carry cargo which could reasonably be expected to damage the Aircraft;
 - i. in any circumstances or place where the Aircraft is not covered by the Insurance as mentioned in this document.
 - ii. be in possession of and under the operational control of the Lessee, be used and operated in accordance with the manufacturer's approved flight manual and the Lessee's operational manual for the Aircraft and all applicable laws and regulations including (without limitation) any applicable Aviation Laws and in compliance with any airworthiness, air operator's or other certificate, license or registration relating to the Aircraft.
 - iii. be operated only under the Lessee's Air Operator's Certificate and by pilots holding valid licenses and other necessary authorizations as may be required by applicable laws and regulations.
 - iv. in a manner which will or may adversely affect the Lessor's rights under any warranty obtained from the manufacturer of the Aircraft or the manufacturer or supplier of any component part of the Aircraft.

- 1.2 (i) Lessee is solely responsible for the determination and implementation of all security measures and systems necessary or appropriate for the proper protection of the Aircraft (whether on the ground or in flight) against (a) theft, vandalism, hijacking, destruction, bombing, terrorism or similar acts, directly or indirectly affecting in any way the Aircraft or any part thereof, or any persons who (whether or not on board the Aircraft) may sustain any injury or damage as a result of any such acts, (b) the use of the Aircraft for the purpose of destruction, bombing, terrorism or similar acts, and (c) the taking, theft or use of any products, chemicals, goods, or materials of any kind, form, or nature located on board the Aircraft or being transported via the Aircraft,
- (ii) Lessor shall have absolutely no responsibility therefore, and
- (iii) Lessee, being in sole operational control of the Aircraft and being in the business of operating commercial aircraft, is uniquely in a position to identify and implement those security measures as are necessary to comply with all applicable Regulations, and as are otherwise appropriate and that in doing so, Lessee has not relied upon, and shall not rely upon, any statement, act, or omission of Lessor.
- 1.3 Registration and Licenses, use and Operation of the Aircraft and Reporting
During the Term of this lease the lessee shall, at its sole cost and expense, register and keep the Aircraft registered in each jurisdiction where such registration may be required under any Aviation Laws and shall make and maintain all registrations, filing or recordings at public offices and registries as may be required to fully protect, preserve and perfect the Lessor's interest as lessor and owner of the Aircraft, and obtain and maintain in full force and effect all licenses, permits, approvals, certificates, authorizations and consents, including, without limitation, airworthiness certificates as are required under any Aviation laws in connection with the operation of the Aircraft and the performance of the Lessee's obligations under this Lease. The Lessee will on demand by the Lessor produce to the Lessor evidence satisfactory to the lessor of compliance with the requirement of this Section.

2. Re-delivery at The expiration of the Term

At The expiration of the Term, the re-delivery of the aircraft shall be Tribhuvan International Airport, Kathmandu, Nepal under the following conditions.

- (a) It shall be responsibility of the Lessee to fulfil all the requirement of CAA Nepal and State of Operator and State of registry at the redelivery of the aircraft.
- (b) Be in such condition that shows that the Lessee has complied with the service and maintenance requirements contained in this section clause 4 (repair and maintenance) hereof
- (c) Be free and clear of all liens, charges, encumbrances and third party claims other than permitted Liens.
- (d) Be clean by aircraft operating standards.
- (e) All the cost of Delivery and Re-delivery shall be borne by Lessee.

3. Monitoring and Reporting:

3.1 During the Term of this Lease, the Lessee shall keep accurate, complete and current technical records respecting all flights and maintenance of the Aircraft, together with all records, logs and other materials required under the Aviation Laws or by the manufacturer(s) of the Aircraft or any components parts of the Aircraft, and shall permit authorized representatives of the Lessor to examine such records at any reasonable time and shall provide copies of such records to the Lessor on frequent interval. Such records shall be the property of the Lessor and upon the return of the Aircraft, the Lessee shall deliver same to the Lessor.

3.2 Without demand, the Lessee shall immediately notify the Lessor in writing of each accident or damage arising out of the alleged or apparent improper manufacturing, functioning or operation of the Aircraft, the time, place and nature of the accident or damage, the names and addresses of the parties involved, persons injured, witnesses and owners of property damaged, and such other information as may be known, and promptly advise the Lessor and provide copies of all correspondence, papers, notices and documents whatsoever received by the Lessee in connection with any claim or demand involving or relating to the alleged or apparent improper manufacturing, operation or functioning of the Aircraft or charging the Lessee or the Lessor with liability, and together with the Lessee's employees, agents and representatives, aid in the investigation and defense of all such claims and shall aid in the recovery of damages from third persons liable therefore, the Lessee shall on demand by the Lessor advise the Lessor in writing of the location of the Aircraft

4. Services and Maintenance

Subject to the obligations of the Lessor, the Lessee shall throughout the Term of this Lease and until redelivery of the Aircraft to the Lessor, at its own cost and expense. Service, maintain, repair, overhaul, test and inspect the aircraft or cause the foregoing to be done, so as to cause the Aircraft to be kept in a fully operative and airworthy condition in good repair and appearance and in compliance with the applicable maintenance manual for the Aircraft and all service bulletins and directives issued by the manufacturer(s) of the Aircraft and all applicable Aviation Laws.

- I. the Lessee, at its own cost, shall promptly repair or replace all parts, components, equipments, engines, accessories, instruments and appurtenances of whatsoever nature which may from time to time be or have been incorporated or installed in or attached to the Aircraft (hereinafter referred to as "Parts") and which may from time to time be beyond economical repair, lost, stolen, destroyed, seized, confiscated, damaged beyond repair or permanently rendered unfit for use, any replacement part to be of the same value and utility as the part replaced.
- II. The Lessee shall ensure that no engine or part is at any time removed from the Aircraft. Any permitted removal and reinstallation shall be at the Lessee's own cost.

- III. - (b) other standard policies as required by rules and regulations of the CAAN.
- (c) Event of Loss, Damage or Regulation
- (d) In this Article, the following words and expressions shall have the following meaning, namely:
- (e) "Event of Loss" shall mean any of the following events with respect to the Aircraft.
 - (i) actual or constructive or compromised or agreed or arranged total loss, or
 - (ii) requisition for title, forfeiture, arrest, seizure, impounding or any compulsory acquisition whatsoever (other than by requisition of hire) by any governmental or other competent authority or by any person acting by or purporting to act by the authority of the same and which results in loss of possession by the Lessee, or
 - (iii) hijacking, theft, disappearance, arrest, impounding, confiscation, seizure or requisition including any total loss as may arise by reason of a requisition for hire in circumstances where sub-article.
 - (iv) above does not apply and which results in loss of possession by the Lessee, or destruction, damage beyond repair or being permanently rendered unfit for normal use of any reason whatsoever; and
- (f) "Repairable Damage" means damage to the aircraft that does not result in an Event of Loss.
- (g) In the event of the happening of an Event of Loss with respect to the Aircraft, the Term shall cease and determine forthwith without notice and within one hundred and fifty (150) days thereof the Lessee shall pay or cause its insurers to pay to the Lessor the Insured Value, subject to the terms mentioned above, of the Aircraft together with any other amounts which are due and payable hereunder.
- (h) In the event of the happening of Repairable Damage, the Lessee shall be liable to reinstate or repair the Aircraft or damage or fault thereto to the Lessor's satisfaction as soon as practicable and the terms and conditions of this Lease shall remain in full force and effect. Any insurance monies received by the lessor in respect of Repairable Damage shall be applied either in or towards the cost of reinstating, repairing or replacing the Aircraft to the Lessor's satisfaction or, if the aircraft shall have been so reinstated, repaired or replaced, in or towards repayment to the Lessee of the cost of such reinstatement, repair or replacement.
- (i) If the Aircraft is requisitioned for hire by any government or other competent authority during the term, then unless and until following such requisition the Aircraft becomes subject to an Event of Loss, the Term shall continue in respect of the aircraft and the Lessee shall be fully responsible for securing due compliance with all its obligations under this lease. For the avoidance of doubt, the Lessor shall not be liable to supply an aircraft or any aircraft part in lieu, if

the Aircraft is lost or damaged or rendered unfit for use or grounded, hijacked, confiscated, seized, requisitioned, restrained or appointed.

6. Covenants of the Lessee

The Lessee hereby covenants with the Lessor that through out the Term of this Lease it will

- (a) punctually pay to the Lessor when due all the monies specified and calculated in accordance with the terms of this Lease and at the time and in the manner herein specified and shall punctually and duly observe and perform the Lessee's obligations under this Lease.
- (b) furnish at its own cost and expense, all fuel, oil, lubricants and other material necessary for the operation of the Aircraft and pay all storage, hanger, loading, customs and airport charges in respect of the Aircraft as the same may be incurred,
- (c) allow the Lessor or its representatives at reasonable time on reasonable notice to inspect the Aircraft,
- (d) remain in and continue to operate substantially the same business as presently engaged in, maintain, persevere and keep in full force and effect its corporate existence, conduct its business in an orderly, efficient and customary manner, satisfy its debts and obligations as they fall due and keep and maintain all its properties in good working order and condition,
- (e) comply with all laws and regulations for the time being in force in Nepal and state of registry/operation including, without limitations, the Aviations Laws.
- (f) not sell or hypothecate or execute a bill of sale affecting the Aircraft or any interest therein or create or suffer to exist any mortgage, charge, pledge, lien (over than Permitted Liens), attachment or other encumbrance or security interest over the Aircraft or any part thereof.

On receiving notice of any of the following as soon as practicable notify and keep the Lessor informed of:

- i) any damage caused to the Aircraft,
- ii) any occasion when work or repairs, other than routine repairs or maintenance of non Time Life Components, is to be carried out on the Aircraft,
- (iii) any loss, arrest, hijacking, confiscation, seizure, requisitioning, impounding, taking in execution, or forfeiture of the Aircraft or any part thereof,
- iv) any substantial injury or damage to any person caused by, or in connection with, the use and operation of the Aircraft,
- v) the occurrence of event of Default or any event or circumstances which, with the giving of notice or lapse of time, or both, might constitute an Event of Default.
- vi) any other event in respect of the Aircraft which might reasonably be expected to involve the Lessor in loss of liability,

vii)do nothing which could reasonably be expected to result in the Aircraft being hijacked, arrested, confiscated, seized, requisitioned for hire, taken in execution, impounded or otherwise taken from the possession of the Lessee; in the event of any such hijacking, arrest, confiscation, seizure, requisitioning for hire, taking or impounding, the Lessee shall use its best endeavors to procure the immediate release of the Aircraft there from and pay, discharge or make adequate provision by way of security or otherwise for all debts, damages, claims and liabilities whatsoever (other than such of the aforesaid which are being contested in good faith and for which adequate provision has been made by way of security or otherwise) which have given or may give rise to liens (other than Permitted Liens) on or statutory rights in rem or claims enforceable against the Aircraft.
