



Notice To all passengers Travelling from Japan

As per the decision of the Government of Nepal (Council of Ministers) dated 2078/11/16, it has been published for the prevention of infection of COVID-19 new variant as well as for the information of all concerned that all the passengers entering Nepal by air route or land route must submit a Certificate of Vaccine against COVID -19.

- **Passengers who are unable to submit a certificate of full vaccine certificate will have to submit:**
 - a) The certificate with a Negative report of COVID-19 test (RT-PCR, Gene Xpert, True NAAT) report by the registered COVID -19 Labs of respective countries within 72 hours from the swab collection time to the check –in time of the flight.
 - b) Sample Method (Nasopharyngeal and Oropharyngeal Swab)
 - c) Must include Personal information (Full Name, Date of Birth, Passport Number)
 - d) Saliva and Antigen test are not acceptable
 - e) Vaccine card/COVID Test certificate will not be mandatory for persons below 5 Years
- Child above five (5) years must have either valid Vaccine Certificate or Negative RT-PCR Certificate.
(If Child reached 5 years on the flight date also must have either vaccine certificate or RT-PCR negative report).

Please make sure to check the following before you departure

- 1) Travel Documents (Passport, valid visa if required)
- 2) Vaccination Certificate or RT PCR test Certificate
- 3) Check the latest entry requirements implemented by government of Nepal

Free Baggage Allowance Facility

- 1) **Business Class:** Total 45 KG (in 2 pcs). One piece should not exceed more than 32 KG.
Hand Carry: 10 KG (1 pc)
- 2) **Economy Class:** Total 35 KG (in 2 pcs). One piece should not exceed more than 32 KG.
Hand Carry: 7 KG (1 pc)
- 3) No of checked Baggage (Max 2 pcs)
- 4) For infant passenger Total free baggage allowance 10 KG.
- 5) Excess Baggage Rate: JPY 2000 Per KG
